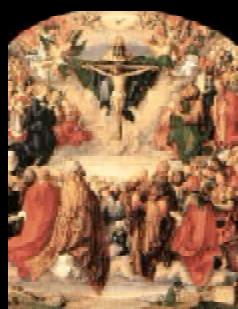

# YOU WERE ASKING by Msgr. P. Stilla

**Q. Why do I need a Confirmation sponsor?**

**A.** The role of a sponsor for Confirmation is an important one. The individual chosen is regarded by

someone who can honestly fulfil a Confirmation Sponsor's role.

**Guidelines to Follow**

the Church as a spiritual helper who is needed and expected to encourage the confirmed person to live life as a practising Catholic. This same role also applies to Baptism Godparents.



**Who Can I Choose?**

The choice is entirely up to you, in consultation with your parents.

However, there are a few Church guidelines which need to be followed. These will help you choose

You can choose an individual who:

n is at least 16 years of age (*or slightly younger, in exceptional cases*);

n has been confirmed and has received First Confession and First Holy Communion in the Church;

n is a practising member of the Catholic Church who honestly tries to live his/her life as a faithful follower of Jesus Christ.

**Q. Can I choose my parents or sister to be my Confirmation sponsor?**

**A.** No, I'm afraid parents cannot

fulfil the role of Sponsor since they already fulfill the role of mother and father. However, if you wish, you can choose a grandparent, a sister or brother, or an aunt or un-



cle, provided that they meet the other requirements that are listed above. To show the link between Baptism and Confirmation, one of your Baptism Godparents can also be chosen.

**Q. My chosen Sponsor has now moved to France and will not be able to attend my Confirmation Mass here. Can she still be my Sponsor?**

**A.** Yes, she can. Although a Sponsor is expected to stand beside you during your Confirmation Mass, this may sometimes not be possible because of distance or for some other valid reason.



In these cases, you can select another person, called a 'proxy' to 'stand in' for your Sponsor. However, the actual Sponsor's name will still appear on your Confirmation record and Certificate.
