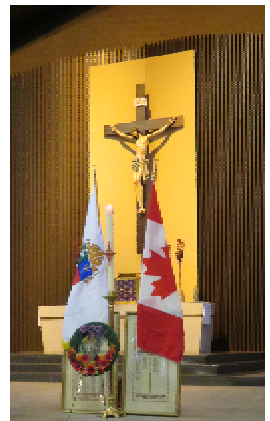

## YOU WERE ASKING by Msgr. P. Stilla

Q. Why are Parish gatherings and retreats important for Christians?

A. Not only are they important but Parish gatherings and retreats teach us essential aspects of Faith and strengthen our community.

The Community of Believers Christ intended His followers to form communities of Faith. He assured us that where two or three are gathered in His name, be it for prayer, for learning, for Christian renewal or for enjoyment together, He is also present among us to strengthen our communal bonds. This happens not only in the Eucharist where we are nurtured by His Word and by the Bread of Life but also in other gatherings of Faith. Reflection, Rest, Prayer & Bonding All of us understand the necessity

of regular time away from work for our physical and emotional wellbeing. The same applies to our spiritual health. This is why we are encouraged to set aside some time in our lives for relaxation, prayer and spiritual renewal, to allow us to temporarily leave behind the usual daily distractions in life and to achieve inner spiritual growth. These can last from as little as a few hours to a full 30 days and can involve one's self alone or a group of persons of faith.
