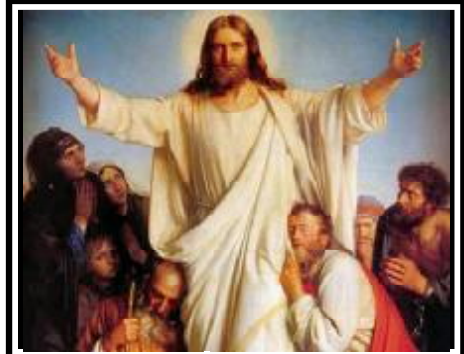

YOU WERE ASKING . . . by Msgr. P. Stilla

Q. Our son who is in Grade 2 in one of our Catholic Schools was baptized as an infant in the United Church. Can he make his First Holy Communion with his classmates next Spring in the Cathedral?

A. Your question is one that is frequently asked at this time of year when the Grade 2 children in our schools register for First Communion in the spring. If you would like your son to receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church, you must first be aware of these common Christian beliefs about Baptism.

Christian Baptism

Your son's baptism in the United Church is recognized by the Catholic Church as a valid Baptism, which initiated him into the Christian Faith. However, it is a common Christian belief that Baptism is a Sacrament which also brings with it, membership in the Christian denomination in which the person is baptized. This membership lasts for life, unless it is later voluntarily renounced. Your son, therefore, is currently a baptized Christian member of the United Church and, if your family practices their United Faith, then he would normally receive the Eucharist according to the

traditions of the United Church, regardless of where his classmates are receiving their First Communion.

A Family Choice for Your Son

Of course, if either one of you or a grandparent is a Catholic and your family has decided that your son should now also become a member of the Catholic Faith and re-



ceive his First Communion, then you can make this request on his behalf. This means that your child would then be received as a full member of the Catholic Church with your full consent in a simple ceremony.

A Serious Decision

This decision should not be taken lightly since it will impact upon your son's spirituality for life. However, if, after serious reflection you still wish your son to transfer to the Catholic Faith and make his First Communion later in the Spring of 2021 here at the Cathedral, then simply notify our Parish Office and you will be guided as to how to initiate and proceed with the process.

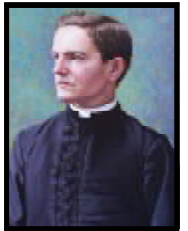
