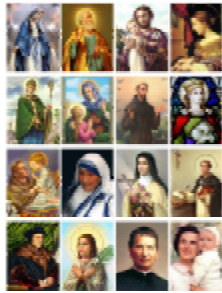
THE "ATTRIBUTES" OF SAINTS IN ART

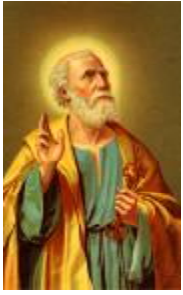

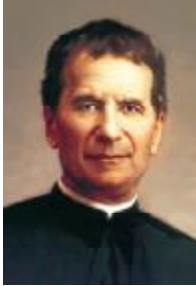

- 1.** Saint: The Virgin Mary (as: Our Lady of Grace or Immaculate Conception)
Attributes: White or blue veil and blue garments; rays of light from her hands (grace).
- 2.** Saint: St. Patrick, Apostle of Ireland - March 17
Attributes: Bishop's Staff and Mitre, green Mass vestments; shamrock; snakes.
- 3.** Saint: St. Anthony of Padova, Renowned Franciscan priest - June 13
Attributes: Brown Franciscan habit; Christ child appearing to him on an open Bible.
- 4.** Saint: St. Thomas More, Lord Chancellor of Henry VIII's England - June 22
Attributes: English lawyer's robes and hat; a judge's scroll in his hands.
- 5.** Saint: St. Peter the Apostle - June 29
Attributes: Holding Keys (of the Kingdom); holding a Bible; an upside down cross).
- 6.** Saint: St. Ann, Mother of Mary - July 26.
Attributes: Veiled older woman teaching a young girl by pointing to heaven or to a scroll.
- 7.** Saint: St. Teresa of Calcutta, Founder: Missionaries of Charity - September 5
Attributes: White Sister's habit and veil with blue stripes, with poor children in her arms.
- 8.** Saint: St. Maria Goretti, Virgin and Martyr - July 6
Attributes: Young girl holding lilies (chastity) and an olive branch (martyrdom).
- 9.** Saint: St. Joseph, Foster Father of Christ - March 19 and May 1
Attributes: A bearded man holding the Christ Child and lilies (chastity); carpenter's tools.
- 10.** Saint: St. Francis of Assisi, Founder of the Franciscan Order - October 4
Attributes: Brown Franciscan habit, birds and animals near him; nail marks on his hands.
- 11.** Saint: St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus, (the Little Flower) - October 1
Attributes: Beige and Yellow Carmelite habit, Crucifix and bouquet of roses in her hands.
- 12.** Saint: St. John Bosco, Founder of the Salesian Order - January 31
Attributes: Young man wearing a white priest's collar and a black priest's robe (cassock).
- 13.** Saint: St. Cecilia, Patroness of Musicians, Cantors and Choirs - November 22
Attributes: A young woman playing a harpsichord or another musical instrument.
- 14.** Saint: St. Margaret, Queen of Scotland - November 16
Attributes: A young woman wearing regal robes and a crown; Symbols of Scotland.
- 15.** Saint: St. Thomas Aquinas, Renowned scholar and theologian - January 28.
Attributes: White Dominican habit with black cape with clasp, shaped like a radiant sun.
- 16.** Saint: St. Gianna Beretta Molla, Pro-life Paediatrician - April 28
Attributes: A smiling young mother usually holding her own young child in her arms.
