



HOLY SATURDAY: MASS OF EASTER VIGIL at 8:00 pm


EASTER SUNDAY: MASSES: 8:30 am *(in Church)*

## YOU WERE ASKING . . . by Msgr. P. Stilla

For the information of our parishioners, I have listed most of the changes that will take place in this year's celebrations for Holy Week and Easter in the Cathedral. These are necessary to adhere to current pandemic guidelines and precautions and to safeguard the health and safety of those who take part in our Masses and Services.

### PALM SUNDAY CHANGES




- ◆ Palms will be placed in the pews throughout the Church and not on a table at the Church entrance, so, there will be no procession with palms at the beginning of Mass ;

- ◆ The Ceremony of the Blessing of Palms with the Reading and Prayers will take place near the Altar;

- ◆ Bishop Colli will bless the palms in the pews from the altar and all are invited to take home the blessed palms that were placed in the pew where you sat during Mass;

- ◆ Since booklets with the Passion Gospel cannot be distributed, the congregation will not be asked to take their usual part in the Reading.

### HOLY THURSDAY CHANGES



- ◆ The ceremonial ritual of the "Washing of Feet" is eliminated;

- ◆ The Procession at the end of Mass will not take place, since the Eucharist will remain in the main Tabernacle in the Sanctuary;

- ◆ There will be no adoration in Our Lady's Chapel after Mass.

### GOOD FRIDAY CHANGES



- ◆ The Procession with the Cross to the Altar will not take place as before. It will be placed in the Sanctuary at the start of the Service;

- ◆ There will be no veneration of the Cross after the Good Friday Service;

- ◆ Booklets with the Passion Gospel cannot be distributed, so the congregation will not be asked to take their usual part in the Reading;

- ◆ Two Services will take place at the same time (*if needed*).

- ◆ For "The Way of the Cross" in the evening, slides will be used instead of the Stations themselves.

### EASTER VIGIL CHANGES

- ◆ The Easter Candle will be blessed near the altar and not at the entrance of the Church. There will be no blessing of new fire, no procession, no lighting of individual candles and no sprinkling of water during Mass.



### EASTER SUNDAY CHANGES

- ◆ There will be no sprinkling with the Baptismal water during Mass.

- ◆ Two Masses will take place at the same time (*if needed*).


