Q. Is there a specific prayer form that would be most appropriate for me to use in my personal daily prayers?

A. There are many authentic forms and styles of personal prayer that the Church has presented to us in every age but ultimately you must decide which form is best suited and most fulfilling to yourself. Often the choice will reflect your personality and temperament. These two aspects of ourselves play a big part in our



prayer preference and satisfaction. In order to enjoy a fruitful prayer life you should match your own personality and temperament to the prayer style or form which is best suited to you.

intellectual understanding of God and the self. The feeling person favours prayer which is a discourse with God and which 'feels' right.

• Judging or Perceptive? Judging persons are concerned with how things should be and pray that God will restore everything as He did in the past. They prefer to re-live historical events through traditional prayer. The "Perceptives" like to see things as they are. They usually dislike formal prayer and prefer more



spontaneity.

PRAYER FORMS

Any of these official Forms may suit you:
 • Benedictine?

St. Benedict, who founded Monasticism, believed that the prayer form best suited to himself and to like-minded followers was a reflective one, prayed or chanted together with others in a secluded environment of calm and silence.

♦ Ignatian/Jesuit?

The Jesuits foster prayer forms, based on the Scriptures which appeal to the intellect and follow a set methodology.

♦ Carmelite?

The prayer style promoted by the Carmelites is transcendental, mystical and traditionally centred on Mary.

♦ Dominican Prayer?

The Dominicans, also known as the 'Order of Preachers' encourage the traditional praying of the Rosary with meditation on its "Mysteries".



YOUR TEMPERAMENT

• Introvert/Extrovert?

Introverts need their private time and space to be re-energized but extroverts prefer to be with others in order to find the same comfort level. While silent and

solitary prayer may be ideal to an introverted person, it is usually boring and dry to an extrovert.

• Sensate/Intuitive?

'Sensates' relate to the world through their senses. For them, touch, sounds and visual aspects are essential in the prayer forms that they like. Instead, 'Intuitive' persons prefer to concentrate on the inner sense of things (creative imagination), and need few externals.

• Thinking /Feeling Person?

'Thinkers' enjoy time-limited prayer which is logically ordered towards an
