

Q. I was told that a 'fish' symbol that I recently saw on a car bumper sticker stands for the Christian Faith. Is this true?

A. Yes, in fact, the symbolic fish emblem does not only stand for the Christian Faith but for Christ Himself!

A Time of Persecution

History recounts that the Christian

Faith was not allowed or even tolerated in the pagan Roman Empire

and elsewhere in the first three centuries after the death of Christ. At that time it was a crime for one to proclaim publicly that he/she was a follower

of Christ. The penalty was imprisonment and even death. It is not surprising then, that the early Christians developed symbols which were not understood by their

enemies but by which they could identify each other. The so-called 'Fish' to

which you refer is one such symbol. Along with it are a number of others which were developed over 2000 years ago and which we still use today in Christian art.

The 'FISH' Symbol of Christ Inscribed within the 'Fish' symbol are the following letters from the Greek alphabet : I.C.Q.Y.S.

These reveal the significance of this

symbol. Each is the first letter of the 5 Greek words: 'Jesus Christ, God's Son, Saviour'. Together, these letters spell, 'Icthus' the Greek word for fish. This is why a fish is

placed around the letters to complete the emblem.

Others Signs

.. 'Chi-Rho'

Pronounced, 'Khig-Row' in English, this equally ancient symbol can often be found embroidered on Mass vestments or placed in stained glass windows.

It consists of the Greek letter, 'X' with a 'P' through it. These are the first two letters of the Greek word, XP-ISTOS, pronounced Christos (Christ). By the way, this is where the 'X' letter that we use in the greeting: 'Merry X-mas' (Christ-mas) originally came from!

.. 'I.H.S'-with a Cross on the 'H' The letters 'I', 'H' & 'S' are the first 3 letters of the Greek word for, 'Jesus'. The early Christians put them together and added a cross through the 'H', to represent the crucified Lord.

.. The Latin 'I.N.R.I.' Inscription These letters which were placed on the sign above Jesus' crucified body reveal the charge that was brought against Him. They are the first letters of 4 Latin words;

Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudeorum (Jesus, Nazarene, King of the Jews).

Pilgrim Statue

In preparation for the Pope's July Visit to Canada, a replica of the Statue of Our Lady of the Cape, which is venerated in the Shrine of Cap-de-la-Madeleine, Québec, is being carried in pilgrimage across Canada to many Dioceses, en route to Edmonton, for the Pope's arrival there, as a herald of reconciliation and healing for all peoples in our land. On Monday, July 18th, this Statue will arrive in our own Diocese and a Marian Service with the recitation of the Rosary and the Blessing of Roses will begin in the Cathedral at 6 pm. Then, at 7 pm, a special Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Colli in our Cathedral.
