A. Outdoor processions have been part of Catholic practice for many centuries. They include 'Way

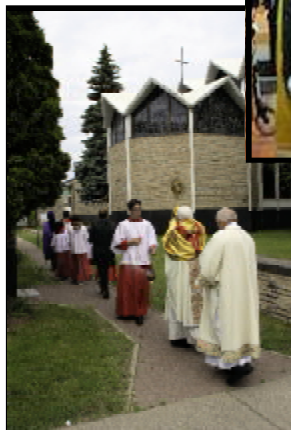

A FESTIVAL OF THE EUCHARIST

It was in the year 1215, that the Solemn Feast of Corpus Christi was first introduced into our liturgical Church calendar. Since that time, Catholics all over the world have been



encouraged to mark the festival annually with public manifestations of Faith. Worldwide, these often included outdoor Masses, Processions and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, usually celebrated on outdoor altars periodically placed along the route of the procession. These were meant to:

- ◆ publicly give witness to our Catholic belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and,
- ◆ to remind everyone, that Christ

OTHER RITES

The Church also celebrates the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist in the following Liturgical Rites:



- ◆ Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament on 1st Fridays of each month;
- ◆ Occasional Forty Hours of Eucharistic Devotions in different Churches throughout the year;
- ◆ Private Reflection, prayer and daily adoration of the Eucharist.

THE NAMING OF CHURCHES

Some Catholic communities also publicly express their Faith in the Eucharist by naming their Churches and Chapels after it (i.e.: Our Lady of the Eucharist, Blessed Sacrament, Body of Christ, Precious Blood, Corpus Christi, and other variations).



This weekend, we will process indoors with the Eucharist at the Masses of Saturday: 5 pm and Sunday: 8:30 am, and outdoors at 10:30 am, with Benediction in our Garden.
