Q. Why can I not choose my favourite secular songs for our Wedding Mass/Ceremony or for a loved one's Funeral in the Cathedral?

A. Your question is often asked of Priests, Deacons and Music Ministers and, in most cases causes unnecessary anxiety in them and in those who ask it. It is not wrong to choose a favourite secular song for your wedding or for a Funeral but, when these ceremonies take place in a Church, some songs are simply not appropriate for a Sacred Place of Prayer. Since every year this issue arises and leads to much misunderstandings between couples and Church clergy, music directors and cantors, I wish, once again, to explain our policy.

Events in Sacred Places

Churches, Temples, Synagogues, or Mosques are generally recognized by people of Faith as sacred places where individuals encounter God in an intimate way. For this reason, not only Weddings and Funerals but, all events which are celebrated within them, should include music befitting the sacredness of the place.

Two Sacred Ceremonies

For Christians, especially Marriages and Funerals are much more than "love events" or "celebrations of one's life". Instead they are rightly, sacred and prayerful rituals in which couples come to a sacred

place to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony before God or, in which family members and friends of the deceased come to pray that their loved one who has died has entered eternal life. For this reason, the songs, which are also prayers, should be addressed to God and should therefore befit a prayerful encounter with the Lord in His House. Besides, there are many other opportunities, at Wedding and Funeral receptions to play or sing favourite secular songs which express mutual love or which remind others of the deceased loved one.

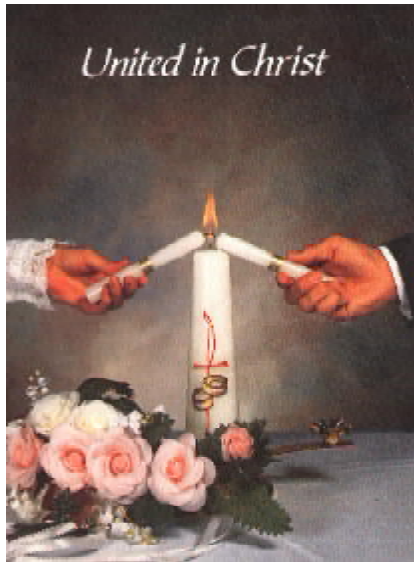
Music Should Befit the Event

As beautiful and as inspirational as many songs are, each is to be used at times and/or in places appropriate to their themes and genres. For instance, although most would appreciate the beauty and majesty of Schubert's 'Ave Maria', it just wouldn't be right or appreciated if it were

played an N.H.L. hockey game or at an outdoor rock concert. It would just not be the appropriate time or place for that piece of music!
