Q. Why don't the parts of the Bible follow in sequence like a book?

A. The simple answer is that the Bible is not one book but a library of books bound together in one.

One Bible but Many Books

Biblical themes and stories seem disjointed because the collection of books which we call the Bible were written at different times and over a period of thousands of years

It was only after the printing press was invented that we bound together these different books into two separate sets called 'Testaments'. Then we also joined



these two Testaments into a single Volume to make it appear like one book. We called these "two sets in one volume", 'the Bible', which literally means, 'The Book'. As we know, the first set which we call, 'Old Testament', recounts



the Faith history of the Jewish People and contains certain themes. To this set, we added the 'New Testament', which records the life of Christ, with its own specific themes.

'Inspiration' is not Dictation

Although God inspired Faith-filled authors to write the biblical books to reveal Himself to us, He did not dictate to them their contents nor did He force the writers to compose them in a particular way.

As a result, Biblical texts reflect the values, culture and personal beliefs of the writers as well as their own interpretations of events. All these, too, add to the seemingly disjointed aspects of the Bible narratives.

Like a Newspaper with a Cover

The Bible is actually more like a newspaper than like a book. Just as

a news journal contains a variety of different genres of writings in its pages (news stories, editorials, cartoons, etc.) so does the Bible. Therefore, in order to understand the meaning of a

Scripture passage, one must first identify the genre of the book in which the passage is found and then interpret it accordingly. These different genres also add to the disjointed effect.

An Enduring Message

It is good to know that despite its many stories and themes, the Bible contains one essential and constant message for all: that a loving God



created us in His image and that, when we rejected Him, He sent us His Son to redeem us and to give us the option to return to our God!
