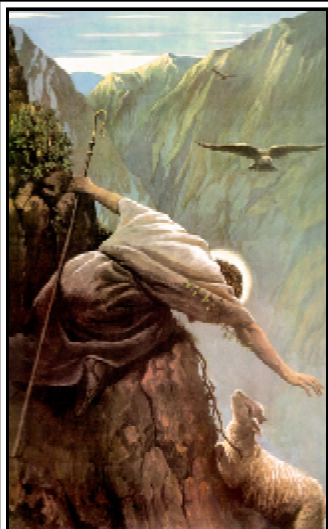

YOU WERE ASKING . . . by Msgr. P. Stilla

Q. Jesus taught us the *'Our Father'* in the Gospels but from where did the Catholic prayers of the *'Hail Mary'* and the *'Glory Be'* come?

A. Together with the Lord's Prayer, these two traditional prayers were taught to us as children by our parents, pastors and teachers.

reminds us that Mary is human like ourselves but that she is also a Saint (*Holy Mary*) because she cooperated with God's plan to be the mother of

Some parts of them are taken directly from the Bible while others are phrases based on the same Gospel message, but added later by the Church.



'Hail Mary': 2 Parts

◆ PART 1

The prayer begins with a greeting and an exclamation of praise, ... words of the angel Gabriel addressed to Mary, as recorded in Luke's Annunciation account.

Praise God from Whom



All Blessings Flow!

"Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you." (Lk. 1:28). The next few words are also Biblical. They were expressed by Mary's cousin Elizabeth during the Visitation: *"Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb"*. (Lk. 1:42)

◆ PART 2

The second section of the Hail Mary is a prayer of petition which is addressed to the *'Holy Mother of God'*. We ask her to join her prayers to ours *'both now and at the hour of our death'*. This final part which completes the prayer was officially added to it by the Church in the 16th century. It



His Son. Though we address Mary here as *'Mother of God'*, this often misunderstood title actually refers not as much to Mary as it does to her Son Jesus, her Son. It acknowledges that Mary is the mother of Jesus Who is both God and human at the same time.

The *'Glory Be'*

The *'Glory Be'* is called a *'doxology'* prayer. *'Doxologies'* are words of worship and praise which we address directly to

God. Doxologies form the opening verses of many familiar hymns like, *'Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow'* or *'O God, our Help in Ages Past'*. Other doxologies are added by some Christians to the ends of prayers, like: *'For Thine is the Kingdom, the Power and the Glory forever'*, added to the Lord's Prayer.
