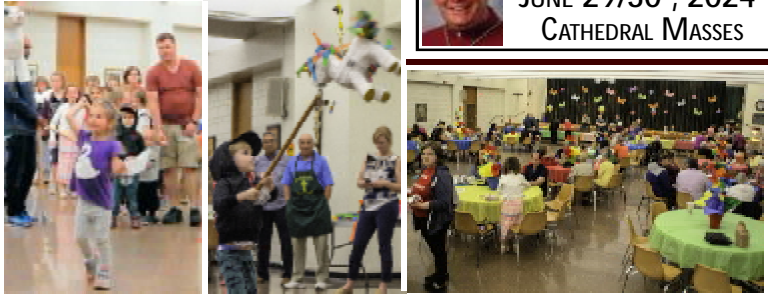
**STILL CARING FOR THE

We know that Bishops are obliged to submit their resignation to the Holy Father as they reach this age. As Bishop Colli's Cathedral Parish, we wish him a happy and restful retirement and pray for his continued good health and wellbeing in his new home in North Bay. Bishop Colli was born on June 17, 1949 in St. Catharines, Ontario. He was called to the Priesthood and was ordained on June 21, 1975, for the Diocese of St. Catharines and first served as Associate Pastor of St. Kevin's Parish in Welland, until 1978. After completing post graduate studies in Canon Law in Rome, our Bishop worked in a number of Diocesan Offices and also served as Pastor of St. Julia's Parish in the City of St. Catharines from 1986 until 1994.

Our Fifth Bishop

On February 22, 1995, he was ordained a Bishop and was first appointed as an auxiliary Bishop of Ottawa. Then in February of 1999 he was named Bishop of Thunder Bay by

Pope John Paul II and was installed in our Cathedral as our 5<sup>th</sup> Bishop on March 25<sup>th</sup>, of that same year, in a solemn Mass of Thanksgiving.

A Variety of Ministries

Besides diligently shepherding our Diocese for the past 25 years, Bishop Colli also worked in various commissions and associations of our Canadian and Ontario Conferences of Bishops, and also served several times as Provincial Spiritual Director of the Ontario Council of the Catholic Women's League of Canada.

Named an Honourary Chief

In 2007, the Indigenous Peoples of our area made him a Chief, giving him the name: "One who shares Good News".

Then, 10 years later, Bishop Colli presented to Pope Francis, a beautiful beaded stole created by Grace Esquaga and Sarah Matasawagon, both of St. Kateri Parish.

What's in a Name?

Our Bishop's name, 'Frederick' means, "Peaceful Ruler" and, for the past 25 years, Bishop "Frederick" has peacefully guided,
