This week, we will celebrate two Saints whose work has influenced our Cathedral Parish and Diocese. Here are brief highlights of their lives. *P.S.*

**July 31<sup>st</sup> : St. Ignatius Loyola**

Born in Spain in 1491, Ignatius was an aristocrat and a mercenary soldier, dedicated to the service of the Spanish Monarchs. At the age of 30, he was injured in battle and, while recuperating, happened to read a volume of the Lives of the Saints, a book that changed his life forever! After reading it, he decided to completely change his life's priorities. He enrolled in courses at the University of

Paris at the age of 34, and was ordained a priest in 1538. While in Paris, Ignatius had inspired a group of like-minded disciples, who travelled with him to Rome to offer their service to the Pope, by teaching the Catholic Faith in the universities of Europe and to preach the Gospel in the New World. The Pope accepted their offer and, the new Order named, 'the Society of Jesus', (*Jesuits*) was founded.

**Our Jesuit Past**

- ◆ In 1667, Jesuits celebrated our first Mass here near Nipigon;
- ◆ Jesuit, Fr. Arpin founded our own Parish in 1893 and later, St. Patrick's Catholic High School, (*originally named Arpin Memorial*), and;
- ◆ Jesuits founded the Parishes of: St. Agnes, St. Andrew, St Peter, St. Margaret and others in the Diocese.

**August 4<sup>th</sup> : St. John Vianney**

Better known as 'the Curé (Pastor) of Ars', John was only three years of age when the French Revolution began in his country in 1789. Due to the anti-Catholic sentiments of the revolutionaries, John was obliged to make his First Communion and pursue Religious Studies to become a priest, secretly. He was re-

luctantly ordained a Diocesan Priest in 1815 by a Bishop who surprisingly felt that John was not suited for the priesthood! In 1818, he was appointed Pastor (*Curé*) of his first (and last) Parish in Ars, a tiny village of 200 people and with only a few who actually practised their Faith. He remained Pastor in Ars until his death, 41 years later. Fr. John showed such extraordinary zeal and commitment for his parishioners that, when he died, Ars had become a model Parish and he, its most dedicated Pastor. John Vianney was canonized in 1925 and named Patron Saint of all Diocesan Priests across the world.

**Our 'Diocesan Priest' Heritage**

- ◆ In 1924, our first Diocesan Priest Pastor, Msgr. Monahan was assigned to our Parish and Diocesan Priests have ministered to us here ever since. Msgr. Peter Monahan was later named the Bishop of Calgary.
- ◆ Today, 29 of our 35 Priests are Diocesan Priests, who minister in Parishes throughout the Diocese.
